Anemone (Anemone blanda) Crocuses (Crocus varieties) Dwarf iris (Iris reticulata) Glory-of-the-Snow (Chionodoxa) Grape hyacinth (Muscari varieties) Hyacinth (Hyacinthus varieties) Siberian squill (Scilla siberica) Striped squill (Puschkinnia libanotica)
